Minutes of Public Meeting March 10 2014

On March 10, 2014 at 7:30 pm, the Derry Conservation Commission met in the 3rd floor meeting room of the Derry Municipal Center, chaired by Paul Dionne in absence of Chair, Margaret Ives.

Acceptance of Minutes:

Paul Doolittle made a motion to accept the minutes of February 24, 2014. Ric Buzzanga seconded the motion. Peg Kinsella abstained. All others were in favor. Motion carried.

Chair's Report & Correspondence:

Saving Special Places will be held April 5 at the Laconia Middle School at 8:00 AM with 10 workshop choices. The cost is \$60 until March 28 and \$75 thereafter.

SELT- Deborah Goard of the South East Land Trust has notified that SELT will soon be monitoring their easements on properties in Derry which are Corneliusen, Shepard, Doolittle and Low. Paul Dionne will request that the chair email members of the date when it is known.

Update on Conservation activities:

There will be a Star Gazing activity on July 21 (rain date July 24) at Broadview.

It was suggested that an area at Broadview be designated for planting milkweed for the monarch butterflies which are under duress.

Go Green will sponsor a program on Bobcats in NH at the Derry Library on March 26.

Other Business:

Jim Degnan has researched the resupply of T-shirts with the DCC logo. He has found the best deal at Jammin Sports where 50 American-made shirts at \$8.50 apiece in an assortment of three sizes would cost \$425. The green colors available are Olive and Hunter. It was suggested that a quantity of 60 would allow 20 each of Med, Large and X-Large. Paul Doolittle motioned to purchase 60 shirts in Hunter Green at a total cost of \$510. Beverly Ferrante seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
