

Field Directions for Derry, New Hampshire

Barka Elementary Field (21 Eastgate Road, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle, turn North on Londonderry Turnpike (Rt 28). Go straight through the lights at Tsienneto Rd and continue North until you reach Eastgate Road on the right. Turn right and follow Eastgate until you see the school. Turn left and the field is back behind the parking lots.

Buckley Field (99 Hood Rd, Derry, NH 03038)

This field is located behind Gilbert H. Hood Middle School. Approaching the Derry Traffic Circle from the center of town on 102, turn left on Hood Road just before the Hoodkroft Country Club. Follow the road up to the school and stay to the left to circle around behind to parking and the field entrance.

Calvary Christian School (145 Hampstead Rd, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle head east on East Derry Rd between the ATM machine and the Mobile Gas station. Continue past the fire station for about 2 miles, the Calvary Christian School will be on your right after crossing Adams Pond Rd at a blinking light. Enter the parking lot and the fields are to the right in the back.

Derry Boys and Girls Club Field (40 East Derry Road, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle head east on East Derry Rd between the ATM machine and the Mobile Gas station. Within a mile, the Derry Boys and Girls Club will be on your left. Enter the parking lot and the fields are to the right in the back.

Don Ball Park & Humphrey Road Fields (14 Humphrey Rd, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle, go South on Londonderry Turnpike (Rt 28). Pass the first set of lights at West Running Brook Middle School and look for Humphrey Road on the left as you descend the hill. Turn left onto Humphrey Road and look for a large sign entrance on the left within a mile. The field is up the hill above the first parking lot on your right.

East Derry Memorial School (18 Dubeau Drive, Derry, NH 03038)

From Rt. 93 take exit 4 (rte. 102 exit) and head East on Rte. 102 towards Derry. Follow Rte. 102 to the Derry Traffic Circle, and take the second right out of the Circle onto East Derry Rd. This road runs along the left side of the Exxon Mobil Gas Station at the Circle. Follow East Derry Rd for approximately 3 miles until the intersection of Olesen Rd. Once you go past the Calvary Christian School and Church, Olesen Rd is the next road on the right. Turn right onto Olesen Rd. Take the third left onto Dubeau Drive. There's a sign at the intersection of Olesen Rd and

Dubeau Drive that says East Derry Memorial School. Follow Dubeau Drive to the end. The field is to the left of the school up the grassy hill.

O'Hara Field (75 Railroad Ave, Derry, NH 03038)

From Rt. 93 take exit 4 (rte. 102 exit) and head East on Rte. 102 towards Derry. From Route 102 turn onto Railroad Ave and follow down almost to the end of the road. The field will be located on the right hand side.

Rider Fields I & II (38 Tsienneto Rd, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle head north on Londonderry Turnpike (Rt 28). Go past Pinkerton High School on the left and then take a right at the first set of lights (Tsienneto Road). Look for the Upper Room on the left within a mile and take the dirt road just after the small white sign. Follow the dirt road a short distance to the parking lot for the fields. Rider II is the smaller, upper field. Rider I is the field just below the parking lot.

Veterans "Vet's" Field (80 Railroad Ave, Derry, NH 03038)

From Route 93, take exit 4 towards Derry Center. Turn right after C & K Restaurant onto Railroad Avenue. Continue to stop sign, Veterans field is across the street.

West Running Brook Middle School Fields (1 West Running Brook Lane, Derry, NH 03038)

From the Derry Traffic Circle head South on Londonderry Turnpike (Rt 28) for a mile or so until the first set of lights. West Running Brook Middle School is a left turn at the lights across from the Fairways Apartment complex. Follow the entrance road around the left of the school. Fields and parking are in the back.
