**Type and Description of Incident / Fire: Motor vehicle collision with severe injuries**

Members of Derry Fire Engine 3 witnessed a motor vehicle collision that occurred in front of their fire station at the intersection of Bypass 28 and English Range Road. They immediately notified fire alarm and responded.

Upon arrival crews found a two car, t-bone, collision, with two patients. One patient was ambulatory with minor injuries while the other was trapped with multiple life threatening injuries. This patient was not wearing their seatbelt. An additional engine and mutual aid ambulance were called to the scene. It took crews twenty minutes to extricate the patient. The Derry Medic 1 crew performed multiple advanced life procedures on the patient during the extrication and as she was transported to the landing zone. The patient was flown by Boston Med Flight to Tuft's New England Medical Center. The second patient was transported by Londonderry Fire Medic to Parkland with minor injuries.

The Derry Fire Department wants to remind everyone to wear their seatbelts. Even with airbags occupants can suffer major or even fatal injuries if they are unrestrained.

Bypass 28 at English Range Road was closed for several hours as the Derry Police Department investigated the accident. For more information please contact Derry Police.

During this call Derry Fire Department was also dispatched to a cardiac arrest on Walnut Hill Road. Derry Medic 2 responded from Island Pond Road Fire Station and a mutual aid fire engine from the Hampstead Fire Department responded to assist them.


**Derry Fire Photo 1:** The driver of the green car was trapped with life threatening injuries.
