



PRESS RELEASE

Type and Description of Incident / Fire:

Motor Vehicle Collision- Vehicle struck a house at #9 Fordway.

Damage to Property:

Vehicle struck a fence, traveled down an embankment and then struck a deck, shed, and single family home at #9 Fordway. The large deck was knocked off its supports and the house sustained structural damage to the side of the house.

Injuries to Fire and Non-Fire Personnel:

A female subject that was believed to be the only occupant of the vehicle was evaluated at a nearby residence, but refused treatment and transport.

The house was occupied by 2 adults and a young child, however they were not injured.

Additional Remarks:

Engine 1 and Rescue 1 utilized struts and shoring to stabilize the structure. The vehicle was removed with careful coordination with LBP Towing. The house remains occupied; however the deck is not safe for use. The deck area was cordoned off with caution tape and the Derry Building Inspector was notified.

Note: There were two other simultaneous emergency calls for service during this incident.
