JAG 2015 Summary

The Town of Derry Police Department was notified that we are eligible to receive a Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$14,790.00. The grant funds must be spent within two years of the award from the United States Department of Justice (DOJ). The grant will be administered by Rockingham County. The county charges each recipient a 5% administration fee. This brings Derry's total net award to \$14,051.00.

Our agency has completed the attached application and will, upon approval, submit it to Rockingham County.

Our JAG application contains four proposed projects:

Project 1: (39) Special Threat Ballistic Trauma Plates;

This project will allow us to replace and equip 39 sworn police officers in our agency with a Special Threat Ballistic Trauma Plate. These plates will increase the ballistic protection of the personal body armor worn by each officer.

The department has requested the funding for 39 plates, as the current ballistic plates, and personal body armor worn by 39 sworn members of the police department is due to expire this fiscal year, FY16.

COST: 39 @ \$75 = \$2,925

Project 2: (4) M4 Style Semi-Automatic Patrol Rifle w/mounted tactical illumination;

This project allows us to equip 4 additional vehicles with a patrol rifle equipped with a mounted tactical illumination device. NOTE: The tactical illuminator is a firearm mounted light, not to be confused with a flashlight.

The addition of this property will allow us the equipment needed to respond appropriately to an armed encounter such as an active shooter in a school.

The rifle mounted tactical illuminator will allow the officer to maintain control of his firearm by maintaining a two handed grip on his firearm while illuminating an area. The result of having two hands on the weapon at the time of deployment results in better control of the firearm.

COST: 4 @ \$975 = \$3900

Project 3: RACK Shelving System for Property/Evidence Storage;

This project will allow us to equip our Cold Evidence/Property Storage building with a RACK Storage Shelving unit.

This project will allow us to utilize the space in the building to our advantage, giving our property room manager the ability to more easily store and organize the contents of the building.

COST: \$3811

Project 4: Internet Evidence Finder (IEF System) & FireWire Bridge (Forensic Hardware);

The project will allow upgrade and augment existing forensic software and hardware utilized by our detective bureau.

The system will allow members of our detective bureau to more easily locate and extract forensic evidence from an electronic device capable of storing data files.

COST: \$5,485

NOTE: The cost of the aforementioned projects total is **\$14,051.00**. This is the amount allocated to the Derry Police Department in the 2015 Justice Assistance Grant.
