SUBJECT: Rockingham Road Construction – Week of October 13, 2014

Motorists are advised they may experience intermittent delays Monday – Friday 7am to 5pm. Work is expected to continue through November 2014. Uniformed police and flaggers will guide traffic through the work zone.

Work Completed Last Week –

Sewer main installation continued along the east shoulder along Route 28 south of Clam Haven northward toward Berry Road.

Permanent trench paving was conducted on the utility trench crossing along By-Pass 28. Clean up and loaming and seeding was conducted at miscellaneous sites throughout the project.

Work for upcoming week –

Complete the installation of the sewer along Route 28 along the east shoulder.

Continued clean-up of the sewer main trench along east shoulder of Route 28, just south of Clam Haven.

Water main installation along west shoulder of Route 28 between Island Pond Road and Berry Road.

Water line crossing across Route 28 By-Pass just north of Humphrey Road.

Weather-permitting, centerline and fog lines will be painted along Rockingham Road.
