APPENDIX A

I. USER CHARGES

A. Minimum charges: Per quarter billable in advance; includes the first 500 cubic feet of usage.

Single dwelling unit \$35.66 per living unit *
Multiple dwelling unit \$35.66 per living unit *
Commercial Establishments \$35.66 per metered service
Industrial Establishments \$35.66 per metered service

* Living Unit is defined by the Derry, New Hampshire Zoning Ordinance and the number of living units billed is based upon Tax Assessors records.

- Minimum charges are applicable only to metered customers.

B. Unit Charges: \$2.98 per 100 cubic feet above the initial 500 cubic feet of usage (allocated in the minimum charge per quarter) billed in arrears.

- Unit charges are applicable only to metered customers. Wastewater usage is based upon the amount of water metered into a resident/business.

C. Flat Rates: \$107.16 per quarter/living unit.

- Flat rates are applicable only to existing unmetered users. A meter is required by the Superintendent when it is reasonably determined by the Superintendent that flows exceed average residential use by more than 20%. Information in Appendix B may be used in such a determination. Flat rates are billable in arrears also.

D. Surcharges: Any user who discharges wastewater with BOD, or suspended solids concentrations in excess of 30 mg/L may be charged a surcharge in accordance with the following formula.

$$Cs = [Be \times B + Se \times S + Pe \times P] Vu$$

Where: Cs = A surcharge for Wastewater of excessive strength.

Be = Operation and maintenance cost for treatment of a unit Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD)

B = Concentration of BOD from a user above a base level (300 mg/L).

Se = Concentration of suspended solids from a user above a unit of suspended solids.

S = Concentration of suspended solids from a user above a base level (300 mg/L)

P_e = Operation and maintenance cost for treatment of a unit of chemical oxygen demand (COD).

P = Concentration of COD from a user above a base level

V_u = Volume contribution from a user per unit of time.

II. WASTEWATER ACCESSIBILITY FEES: one time charge

- A. \$567.00 per Bedroom for residential discharges.
- B. \$3.40 per gallon per day based upon projected discharge flows in accordance with Appendix B for commercial, industrial, or institutional discharges.

III. PERMIT APPLICATION FEES:

- A. \$50 for Residential permits
- B. \$100 for Commercial, In Institutional Permits
- C. \$250 for Industrial User Discharge Permits

IV. SEPTAGE DISPOSAL FEES & RATES

- A. Septage Haulers License - \$25.00/truck
- B. Septage Disposal Rates - \$32.00 per 1,000 gallon of septage

V. TOWN INSPECTION FEES


- A. \$35.00/hr minimum .5 hour charge

VI. INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT PROGRAM CHARGES & FEES


- A. Direct back charge of all contractor and/or consultant costs plus an additional administrative charge equal to 10% of the direct cost.
