#### Discussion of Flagged Items

Administrator Caron – The Coefficient of Dispersion (COD) – Derry's COD is 9.34%. The CIP funding was removed by the Town in 2014-2015. In FY 2019 fiscal conditions improved and we instituted some tax funding. The FY 24 budget preliminarily anticipates tax support for the CIP at \$300,000.

Councilor MacEachern makes a MOTION to add in the Veterans Credit as previously discussed and to increase the Capital Improvement Plan to \$650,000 in the budget to be presented, seconded by Councilor Granese
