Vehicle Maintenance

Building and Grounds

Assists with maintenance of historical buildings, and removal of hazardous and/or dangerous trees under the Town's jurisdiction to ensure the safety of the citizens.

Code Enforcement

In addition, the Division is responsible for enforcement of the Town's Zoning Ordinance and other associated regulations.
