Chairman's Report - Joshua Bourdon

The Derry Town Council presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Matthew Robinson for an Eagle Scout Project with Boy Scout Troop 405. He was instrumental in constructing an informational kiosk for the Derry Rail Trail which included a bake sale to raise money to purchase materials, a Derry Rail Trail rules sign and a historical sign about the Ice Harvesting that took place at Hood Park.

Town Administrator's Report – David Caron

CFO Susan Hickey gave a presentation on the First Quarter Financial Report. September 30th is 25% through the fiscal year. General fund revenue and expenditures are at 20% and 21% respectively. Cable revenue and expenditures are at 0% and 10% respectively. Water revenue and expenditures are at 32% and 17% respectively. Wastewater revenue and expenditures are at 23% and 15% respectively.

Continental paving has milled sections of Birch Street, Tsienneto Road and Crystal Avenue. The final layer of pavement is tentatively scheduled to be placed on Tsienneto Road, Birch Street, and Crystal Avenue during the week of October 9th.

Contactor crews for Liberty Utilities are continuing progress on gas main installation for the South Range School and they have also completed work within the Town right-of-way on Eastgate Road. Crews have installed temporary water mains, drilled and blasted ledge and installed approximately 1500 feet of sewer main on Brady Avenue. With about 400 feet of sewer main remaining to be installed in Phase I, the mainline sewer installation is scheduled to be completed by October 6. A second service crew is returning to each property to install a sewer service to the property line.

A few meetings ago, Nancy Francis appeared before the town council to announce a fundraiser to be held at Gallien's Beach with a date of February 17th. This will be contingent upon weather.

A preliminary design of the Sawyer Property Conservation Easement property to be subdivided on Island Pond Road has been selected by SELT.

The CIP template has been distributed to departments with a return date of November 3.

DPW has posted an RFP for Hood Park cameras and related facilities with a due date of November 3.

NHDOT advised the town that they still plan on beginning construction on Exit 4A in 2019. The town has received proposals to install solar at Marion Gerrish and the transfer station.

Public Forum - *30 Minutes* Open Public Forum – all agreed

Donald Burgess: High St – Asked if it was possible to give new police officers a one-time bonus for signing a contract with Derry. Would like the State/Town to look into using more LED light bulbs saying that they pay for themselves over time. Questioned the flood plan for 19 Elm Street and the weeds growing on the property.

Councilor Morgan moves to extend the time for Mr. Burgess, seconded by Councilor Katsakiores – all agreed
