Set up photo banners in optimal location – right behind starting line for photo opportunities showing the Derry Energy & Environmental Committee and Junior Solar Sprint banners

Rope off more space at the bracket board

Use projector to project bracket onto the screen on the stage

Set up registration information to have available for race participants when they get there

Prepare media kits and have available for media: teams, tally on participants, student names, ages, grades, teachers, and school. Print program guide showing the bracket and order of events, etc.

Pick up track before awards begin

Tom Minnon sportsmanship award - "Minnon Cup" - (set up criteria for winning)

Potentially set up two tracks if event grows larger

Future Ideas:

Event has currently been run in the model of the Junior Solar Sprint, not actually registered. If registered, winning teams will be able to compete nationally.

Would need to:

- Move the event to earlier in the year (nationals are held in June)
- Certify with association
- Review and follow all rules
