Type and Description of Incident / Fire: Motor Vehicle Collision with 3 people trapped.

At 7:59 p.m. the Derry Fire Department Communications Center received a report of a motor vehicle collision with unknown injury at 144 Island Pond Rd in Derry. An engine and an ambulance were dispatched to the location. We then received further details that three people were injured and trapped. We dispatched additional resources of a rescue pumper, two additional ambulances and a Battalion Chief.

We arrived to find a pick-up truck had struck a tree with three males injured and trapped. Parkland Medical Center was alerted and a Boston Med Flight Helicopter was requested to the scene. All personnel worked with numerous power tools to extricate all three subjects. Two males were transported to PMC with non-life threatening extremity injuries. One male subject was transported to Boston Medical Center by Boston Med Flight with serious injuries.

Derry Police are investigating the incident.
