



## PRESS RELEASE

### **Type and Description of Incident / Fire:** House Fire

At 12:10 hrs the Derry Fire Department Communications Center received a report by the Derry Police Department that an Officer was checking a smoke condition on North Shore Rd. Three Engines, a Battalion Chief and a Londonderry Ambulance were dispatched to the area.

Fire Crews arrived on scene to find heavy smoke and fire in a 2 story house with nearby residential exposures. Neighbors reported they believed the resident was still in the building. Fire Crews encountered heavy contents on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor that made searching the building challenging.

The fire was brought under control at 1:06 p.m. The home was considered uninhabitable. There were no injuries to civilians or fire department personnel. Fire crews removed and attempted to resuscitate two family dogs. Red Cross responded to the scene to assist the occupants. Mutual Aid was received from the Londonderry and Windham Fire Departments. Tankers were provided by Auburn, Chester, Hampstead and Sandown. Salem, Manchester, Hudson, and Pelham provided Station Coverage. The cause of the fire is currently under investigation.
