### NALOXONE TRAINING PRESS AVAILABILITY

**Derry, NH** – Members of the press are invited to attend a Naloxone (also known as Narcan) administration demonstration being conducted by Derry Fire Department and Professional Fire Fighters of Derry (see details below). Due to the success of the first Naloxone training on June 8<sup>th</sup>, local agencies in coordination with New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will conduct a second Naloxone training for community members who are affected by an opioid addiction. The trainings are being conducted in response to the dramatic increase in opioid overdoses locally and deaths statewide. Naloxone is an emergency treatment used to reverse life-threatening effects associated with an opioid overdose. This training is being offered to the public on July 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at the Derry Friendship Center. In an effort to maintain the privacy of training participants, this press availability has been scheduled to allow for photography and videography of the Naloxone administration demonstration prior to the training. No photography or videography will be allowed during the public training.
