

PRESS RELEASE

Type and Description of Incident / Fire: At 00:06 hours - Derry Fire Alarm received a single call from the occupant of #23 Hubbard Hill Rd reporting a fire in the attached garage. Derry Fire Department Engines 2,4,1,3, Medic-1 and Car-1 with a total 15 firefighters responded.

On arrival - Derry Eng 2 found a 24 x 50 two-story wood frame residential home with heavy fire in the attached garage. A working fire assignment was requested. Units from Auburn, Chester, Hampstead, Londonderry, Sandown, and Windham responded with 18 additional firefighters.

Crews were able to contain the fire to the attached garage. An aggressive interior attack using multiple handlines with coordinated ventilation stopped the fire before it could extend into the main house.

The family of 4 and their pet dog self-evacuated the building before arrival of the Fire Department. The Derry Police Department provided traffic control and security at the scene. Eversource cut electrical power to the home. Derry Fire Stations were cover by Hudson, Manchester, Nashua, and Salem.

Damage To Property: The garage sustained heavy fire, smoke, and water damage. The contents of the garage including two automobiles that are considered a total loss. The main house and breezeway sustained moderate smoke damage.

Injuries To Fire and Non-Fire Personnel: No reported injury to Occupants or Firefighters.

Additional Remarks: The fire appears to be accidental in nature; investigators are continuing their efforts to determine the exact cause of the fire.
