



## PRESS RELEASE

### Type and Description of Incident / Fire:

Electrical Fire - Wastewater Treatment Facility - 50 Transfer Lane Derry, NH

The Derry Fire Communications Center received a Radio Box Alarm at 1124 hrs from the Wastewater Treatment Facility located on Transfer Lane.

Companies arrived and noted smoke from a roof hatch at the back of the building. The fire was quickly extinguished.

Companies ventilated smoke from the structure and assured the building was safe before allowing occupants to return.

A liquid chlorine storage tank that was located in the room was not involved in the incident. Fire and smoke damage was contained to the room of origin.

### Additional Remarks:

The quick actions of the Derry Wastewater Employees assisted in resolving the incident by immediately closing the door to the fire room – this action greatly diminished the spread of the smoke and fire. They then advised initial fire crews that all employees were evacuated and accounted for, as well as, information on quick access and hazards in the fire room.

The incident is being investigated by the Derry Fire Prevention Bureau.
