	• Restoration of Nesmith plot. TJ o reached out to see what it would cost to refurbish the front gates and Nesmith plot. TJ is speaking with Matt Lazaro of Derry and estimates \$1,600 to do the repairs. A motion was made by Paul Lindemann and seconded by Karen Blandford-Anderson to approve the expenditure of \$1,600 to restore the Nesmith plot. (Approved 3-0)

Motion was made by Karen Blandford-Anderson and seconded by TJ Cullinane to donate \$1,000 to the fund for restoration of the clock tower. (Approved 2-0-1) Paul Lindemann abstained. (Check request will be put in, made out to the Friends of the Meeting House with note for the Tower Clock Restoration)</li> </ul>
