- ➤ A copy of your 2020 IRS Tax Return
- Bank Statements
- Copies of paychecks, unemployment, disability payments and Social Security Checks (unless visible in the bank statement)
- ➤ Copy of bill or Rental Agreement with the current amount due for which you are requesting assistance.
