Minutes

-Derry Building Codes

NH Saves no longer on Derry Town web site. Check with Bob Mackey on why it was removed.

Solar is still under consideration for inclusion in the Honeywell project.

-Derry municipal update

Vendors resubmitted proposals, using current electrical rate of \$0.13/kwh. Payback increased by 10-15%. REC prices have also dropped that may affect payback – if SB 129 bill is signed by Governor Sununu, then REC prices should recover.

Town will go ahead with applications for Marion Gerrish and DPW projects to PUC so that they can be grandfathered at the current net metering rates, if the Town Council should decide to go ahead with these projects. Expect to present to Town Council in July.

NuWatt (John Teague) who was recently part of 7 residential installations in Derry as part of SolarUp, presented background of the company and covered their proposals for DPW (fixed ground mount) and Marion Gerrish (roof mount). Nuwatt will provide an optional quote using a tracking system for comparison purposes. For the optional, large proposal for the landfill, where piered foundations cannot be used, ballast foundations would be required and therefore the price per watt would be closer to \$1.85.

NuWatt's previous quote utilized Solar World for PV panels but they have since gone out of business. NuWatt provided new prices for Cell Fab (Canada) at \$1.85/watt and Q-Cell (Chinese) for \$1.80/watt.
