Consent Agenda:

Motion to approve minutes made by John O'Connor and seconded by Tom Cardon. Motion passed 5-0-1 with Josh abstaining and Mary not present for vote.

New Business:

Legislative update given by John O'Connor, focusing on Net Metering bills moving through the Legislature.

Craig Lazinsky gave an update on Community Power. He participated in a call with CPP NH that discussed how communities are progressing with Community Power and what their needs are.

Jeff brought up election of officers and it was suggested that we wait until April.
