John O'Connor gave a brief update on pending legislation. He will be co-sponsoring a bill to increase solar project capacities to 5 megawatts.

## Goals: Review- Discuss – Status

### Revised Goals

- Create cost effective solutions for reduced energy use on town-controlled properties (e.g. LEDs)
- Produce enough renewable energy to meet the municipal portion of the town's annual electricity consumption by 2025 and achieve Net Zero for this segment
- Educate & assist schools, businesses and residential home owners in evaluating and implementing their own renewable energy projects
- Evaluate Feasibility of converting Town owned vehicles to electrical and achieve Net Zero for this segment
- Evaluate feasibility of converting Town heating systems to renewable and achieve Net Zero for this segment

Josh Bourdon met with Dave Caron, Mike Fowler and Jim Morgan concerning the monitor for the solar array at the Transfer Station. All parties are aware that the monitor is free and just needs to be hooked up.

Elijah Garrison of Revision Energy did a presentation for a proposed solar project to be located at the closed town landfill.

The committee discussed next steps for this project.
