Draft Minutes

New Business

John O'Connor gave a legislative update on energy related bills that are of importance to our committee. Notably, sb 159 has passed the Senate with enough votes to be veto proof but is still in the Senate. A number of bills were either tabled or sent to interim study and will probably die there.

Craig Lazinsky gave an update on a draft energy ordinance for solar and wind power that he has been working on with Mary Till. The committee discussed the proposed ordinance with no action taken.

Jeff gave a brief update on Group Net Metering for the town and schools.

Jeff gave an update on the EPA tool. Craig Cunningham will have more information at our next meeting.

Craig Lazinsky and Tom Cardon gave an update on Community Power. The committee discussed continuing to move forward at a slow pace so that we can gather more information.

Member Comments

Craig Lazinsky responded to Josh's suggestion to lobby other communities for renewable energy support. He presented a letter for the committees' consideration to be sent to our State

Representatives, Senator and Governor Sununu from the Town Council. We discussed the letter and will have further discussion at a future meeting
