Final Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:37 Note: The committee met in the parking lot at 5:45 for EV Demos of Ford Lightning and Tesla Model 3.

Consent Agenda:

Motion to approve minutes made by Josh and seconded by Craig. Motion passed 7-0-1 with Jess abstaining.

New Business:

Jeff discussed the performance data of his Ford Lightning for presentation to the police department. Jeff and Chris discussed with the committee the EVS modeling tool.

Jeff gave an update on the Eversource proposal for residential and commercial EVCS.

Jeff discussed with the committee the location for an L3 charging system to be in place with the completion of the Landfill Solar project. Mike will be looking into the design and location.

Jeff discussed having a demonstration of EVs for town departments and employees.

Mike gave an update on the Landfill Solar project. Encore is working on the final environmental permits and electrical design.

Mike Fowler has not heard the status of the Department of Energy \$500 thousand grant but we should hear by the end of the month and he is confident that we will be getting the grant.

Craig gave an update on P.R. On September 17th the committee will be sharing a booth with the Conservation Committee at Derryfest. On October 14th there be a Community Power forum.

Members of the committee, school board and Encore will do a site visit at Derry Village School on September 21st to see if it is possible to install ground-mounted solar panels. Note: This meeting was canceled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Jess said the school roof report will be coming out soon. We are hopeful that solar panels will be included in the new roof designs.

No update on community power.

Josh will be presenting a letter to the town council for approval to ask Pinkerton Academy to get serious about installing solar panels at the school.

Other Business:

Motion to adjourn was made by Josh and seconded by Chris. Motion passed 8-0.
