

Buglaries Released June 11, 2014

PRESS RELEASE

On June 10, 2014 at 9:37 PM the Derry Police responded to 29 Birch Street for a reported burglary. Officers spoke with an elderly female who stated that moments earlier she confronted a man that walked out of her bedroom carrying a flashlight. The man fled when she asked him what he was doing in her home. Derry Police assisted by a New Hampshire State Police canine swept the area for over an hour but could not locate the man. He is described as approximately 6'2' tall, thin build wearing military looking clothing. Officers discovered that forced entry was made to the residence through a window while the victim was at home. Nothing appears to have been stolen.

On June 11, 2014 at 7:18 AM Derry Police responded to another burglary that occurred at 76 East Broadway. The residents reported that they heard sounds in their kitchen at about 8:00 PM on June 10th but dismissed it as possibly coming from a neighboring apartment. This morning they discovered that a purse, wallet and tablet were missing from their home. They believe that someone entered through an unlocked door, stole these items and fled. There is no description of a suspect in this crime.
