Lateral Transfers: Lateral Transfers from a New Hampshire Career Department do not need a CPAT Certificate, **have only a six-month probation, and will receive a step raise after 6 months.**

FF/EMT is \$47,916 to \$62,964 + benefits, incentives and overtime.

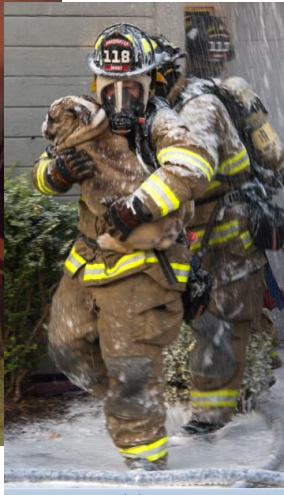


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About the Derry Fire Department

The Derry Fire Department is strongly supported by a vibrant community, is an ISO 3/3y, CAAS Accredited department that responds to over 5000 Fire and EMS calls annually. The DFD operates out of four stations with a daily shift staffing of 16 firefighter/EMTs and firefighter/paramedics. Line personnel work a shift schedule of 24 hours on duty with 72 hours off duty. All operations personnel are dual-role cross-trained; staffing an ALS Ambulance, a Paramedic Engine, and/or a Truck Company.

The Derry Fire Department offers regular full-time employees excellent pay, tuition reimbursement and benefits.
