SUBJECT: Grant authority to accept seized/forfeited property from the U.S. Department of the Treasury

PURPOSE

To grant authority to the Town Administrator to execute documents and accept seized or forfeited property from the U.S. Department of the Treasury for case# MF15HS15MF0004 and case# MF15HS17MF0003.

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR COMMENTS

The Council is encouraged to adopt Resolution #2017-087.

BACKGROUND

Officers from the Derry Police Department participated in multi-jurisdictional local/federal investigations in which the federal government moved to seize property connected to those investigations. As a result, the Town of Derry is eligible to receive a share of any property that has been seized/forfeited pursuant to those investigations.

In order to receive the property, the Town Council must designate a person that has the authority to accept the seized/forfeited property.

DISCUSSION

The Town Council must designate a person authorized to accept funds or property received as a result of federal sharing associated with the two cases listed previously.

FISCAL IMPACT

The acceptance of these funds or property will have a positive impact on the budget since the revenues were not previously predicted in our budget.

RECOMMENDED ACTION BY COUNCIL

The Town Council move to authorize the Town Administrator to accept seized/forfeited property associated with the cases listed above.
