SUBJECT: United States Department of Justice, Bulletproof Vest Partnership

PURPOSE: Consider applying for and accepting funding from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for Personal Body Armor under the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program.

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR COMMENTS: The Town Council is urged to support this request after receiving public input at the October 18 public hearing.

BACKGROUND: Recently we were notified by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) that the Derry Police Department is eligible to receive an award under the Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) program. We have participated in the program for a number of years.

The FFY22 award may be used for National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant armored vests. The awarded funds can be used until August 31, 2024.

Based on our history and current needs, we have projected that we will need to purchase eighteen (18) bulletproof vests during this timeframe. We anticipate that the BJA will award us up to \$11,187 which is half of the cost of the estimated eighteen bulletproof vests. The BJA would reimburse the police department for up to 50% of each vest after the purchase has been made.

DISCUSSION: Authorization is requested for the Town Administrator to accept the grant funds which will not exceed \$11,187 for the purchase of personal body armor.

FISCAL IMPACT: The acceptance of these funds will have minimal impact on the budget since the purchase of the armor is considered in our operating budget as well as the anticipated revenue received as a result of this program.

RECOMMENDED ACTION BY COUNCIL: Grant authority to the Town Administrator to apply for, accept and expend without further Town Council action, grant funds associated with the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, FFY22 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program in the amount of up to \$11,187.

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RESOLUTION

Number 2022-072

To Accept a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant for Personal Body Armor

WHEREAS, Section 9.15 of the Town Charter authorizes the Town Council to accept grant funding; and

WHEREAS, funding is available through the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for Personal Body Armor; and

WHEREAS, the Town foresees the need to purchase eighteen vests during this budget period, and the DOJ would reimburse the Town for 50% of the cost of this purchase (\$11,187); and

WHEREAS, the availability and use of Personal Body Armor is vital to an officer's safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED IN COUNCIL that the Town Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for, accept and expend such funds derived from the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance grant and to enter into agreements with the DOJ as may be necessary to finalize receipt of this grant funding.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
