Supervisors of the Checklist Sessions

The Supervisors of the Checklist will meet at the Derry Municipal Center to register new voters and to update names or addresses of voters with changes at the sessions listed below. The Supervisors will approve additions, removals, and changes to the voter checklist at each session.

December 19, Tuesday, from 1 – 2PM January 4, Thursday, from 6 – 7PM January 16, Tuesday, from 6 – 7:30PM

<u>January 16 is the last opportunity to register to vote ahead of the presidential primary on January 23.</u>
After that session, residents may register to vote at the polling place on election day.

Voter Registration Options

Residents have 3 options to register to vote:

- apply with the Town Clerk on weekdays from 7AM 4PM through January 16.
- register with the Supervisors of the Checklist at a session; or
- register at the polling place (Pinkerton Academy Field House) on primary day, January 23.

Address and Name Changes

Registered voters can update their name or address on the checklist with the Town Clerk during office hours, with the Supervisors of the Checklist at a session, or at the polls by informing the ballot clerk at check-in. *Please note*: Per RSA 654:32, party affiliation is locked for the 2024 presidential primary.

Voter Information Lookup Tool

Registered voters can view their registration (name, address, and party affiliation) online using the Secretary of State's Voter Information Lookup Tool: https://app.sos.nh.gov/voterinformation
Registered voters can also find the location and hours of their polling place, view sample ballots, or track their absentee ballots using the SOS Voter Information Lookup tool.

Viewing the Voter Checklist

Copies of the voter checklist are posted with the Town Clerk, in the lobby of the Derry Municipal Center, and at the Reference Desk at the Derry Public Library.

Role of Party Affiliation in a Primary

Party affiliation is chosen by the voter. Voters can affiliate with the Democratic or Republican parties or be Undeclared. Voters affiliated with a party can vote in their party's primary. Undeclared voters can choose to vote in a party's primary by declaring an affiliation to the ballot clerk at check-in. If they wish to un-affiliate with the party chosen, they can do so by visiting the Change Back to Undeclared table after voting that day or with the Town Clerk or Supervisors following the primary.
