DO NOT THROW AWAY TOXIC PRODUCTS!

DO BRING TOXICS SUCH AS:

From the house From the workbench From the Yard From the Garage fertilizers with acids bathroom Cleaner brush Cleaner pesticides antifreeze disinfectants corrosives car waxes/polish fungicide furniture polish oil based paint/stain metal polish insect spray creosote rust preventative driveway sealer lighter fluid mothballs solvents thinner/turpentine pest strips/traps flea powder oven cleaner pesticides gasoline photo chemicals wood preservatives radiator flush rug cleaner wood stripper poisons pool chemicals roofing tar thermometers

DO NOT BRING:

Batteries, latex paints, explosives, asbestos, or radioactive and infectious wastes.

Helpful Tips on Dealing with Toxic Products:

Follow and use the safety instructions on the label.
Give leftovers to friends and neighbors.
Keep the product in its original container and intact.

Do not mix toxic products!

Use in a well ventilated area

Keep flammables away from heat, sparks and flames
