<u>From the Yard</u> fertilizers pesticides fungicide insect spray lighter fluid pest strips/traps pool chemicals poisons From the Garage acids antifreeze car waxes/polish creosote driveway sealer flea powder gasoline radiator flush roofing tar

<u>From the house</u> bathroom Cleaner disinfectants furniture polish metal polish mothballs oven cleaner photo chemicals rug cleaner thermometers <u>From the workbench</u> brush Cleaner corrosives oil based paint/stain rust preventative solvents thinner/turpentine wood preservatives wood stripper Rechargeable Batteries

DO NOT BRING:

Automotive or alkaline batteries, latex paints, explosives, ammunition, used oil, or radioactive and infectious wastes

Helpful Tips on Dealing with Toxic Products:

Follow and use the safety instructions on the label. Give leftovers to friends and neighbors. Keep the product in its original container and intact. **Do not mix** toxic products!
