A monthly meeting of the Derry Highway Safety Committee was held Thursday, January 21, 2016 at the Derry Municipal Building Center. Meeting was called to order at 9:00 am.

## OLD BUSINESS

### **Nick Zaharias – Paul Ave – Radar Speed Limit Signs**

Alan Cote explained the traffic study and stated that the road was posted with a 30 mph sign. Town roads have a speed limit of 35 mph unless posted in the Ordinance. Paul Ave does not have an Ordinance posting the road at a 30 mph. He felt the road should be posted at 35 mph. Alan asked Chief Garone what the guidelines were.

Ed Garone stated that the speed limit should be 30 mph if the driveways are closer than 300 feet apart.

Scott Savard felt the speed limit should remain at 30 mph.

Alan Cote went on to explain that the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile of the traffic was traveling at 43.2 mph, which is 15 mph over the speed limit and agreed it could use some attention. The 10 mile per hour/pace was 22.32, mph which was the largest percentage of the traffic.

**The Committee decided that the Police Department put up a temporary radar sign or trailer to see if that would help slow that traffic down.**
