ARTICLES

2. Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Eighty-Six Million, Two Hundred Sixty-One Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars (\$86,261,396)? Should this article be defeated, the 2018-2019 operating budget shall be Eighty-Six Million, Seven Hundred Nineteen Thousand, Eight Hundred Forty-One Dollars, (\$86,719,841), which is the same as last year with certain adjustments required by previous action of the School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X, and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **(Recommended by the Derry School Board)**
