**ARTICLES**

2. Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$99,036,260? Should this article be defeated, the 2023-2024 default budget shall be \$99,047,580, which is the same as last year with certain adjustments required by previous action of the School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X, and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **(Recommended by the Derry School Board)**

3. Shall the School District establish a Maintenance and Repair Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for the purpose of funding the maintenance and repair of the District's buildings, grounds, facilities and infrastructure including the costs of engineering for maintenance and repair projects, and raise and appropriate the sum of \$700,000 to be placed in this fund, and further name the School Board as agents to expend this fund? Intended projects include, but are not limited to, the maintenance, repair and replacement of the District's security, fire alarm, sprinkler, plumbing, and HVAC systems, and other infrastructure as well as the maintenance and repair of the District's grounds, including but not limited to, ball fields and parking lots. The fund will not be used for the construction of new buildings or the acquisition of additional land. **(Recommended by the Derry School Board)**

4. Shall the School District establish a Roof Repair and Replacement Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for the purpose of funding the maintenance, repair and replacement, of roofs on the District's buildings including the costs of engineering of those maintenance, repair and replacement projects and raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,800,000 to be added to this fund with this sum to come from the June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1 and not to be raised from additional taxation, and further to name the School Board as agents to expend this fund? **(Recommended by the Derry School Board)**
