- Platform: Survey Monkey + Hard-copy
- Window: 12/5/2015 to 12/26/2015
- Passive:
 - Open to general public (no targeted sample)
 - No cold calling or mail services
 - Minimal demographic data collected


625 responses under analysis

- 18 hard-copy responses






2. Should the town invest in an **Economic** Development **Coordinator?**


3. Should the town provide financial support for improvements to existing buildings in the downtown?






5. Should we continue efforts to lower taxes in the Town of Derry?


