The Town of Derry Police Department was notified that we are eligible to receive a Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$13,761. The grant funds must be spent within two years of the award from the United States Department of Justice (DOJ). The grant will be administered by Rockingham County. The county charges each recipient a 7% administration fee, which is \$963. This brings Derry's total net award to \$12,798.

Our agency will complete the application and will, upon approval, submit it to Rockingham County.

Our JAG application contains several proposed projects:

Project 1: Purchase a Talino KA-101 Forensic Workstation (Cost - \$6,949)

The Talino workstation allows the Derry Police Department personnel to forensically process mobile devices, computer hard drives, and other digital storage media efficiently. This will be an upgrade of the current forensic equipment that we are currently using. In addition to the processing benefits, this Talino workstation will serve as a temporary storage for digital evidence in the many active and recently active cases that the Derry Police personnel are working on.

<u>Project 2: Purchase of (1) Synology DiskStation 12-Bay NAS Enclosure, (1) Synology 16GB</u> Memory Module, and (12) Synology 6TB Internal NAS HDD (Total Cost \$3,949.86)

The Synology DiskStation will serve as the Derry Police Department's digital evidence storage to keep sensitive material and other forensic cases separate from the standard Derry Police Department evidence server that is maintained by the Town's IT department. In addition, as more and more cases become heavily involved with large amounts of digital evidence, this server will accommodate our current need and allow for growth in the future if the need arises. As cases become older and there is less need to immediately access their data, they will be transferred from the Talino workstation to the Synology DiskStation to wait until case disposition.

<u>Project 3: Purchase a DataPilot 10 Field Acquisition Device and associated cables and adapters (Total Cost \$1,995)</u>

The DataPilot is a tool that enables detectives and patrol personnel to quickly extract data from mobile devices and even adjust the amount of data to be extracted. By being able to specify a time range of data requested, victims and witnesses will be more likely to allow a limited extraction of their devices instead of a complete data dump.
