

RESOLUTION

Number 2021-030

To Intervene Before the Public Utilities Commission Regarding Electric Vehicle Time of Use Rates

WHEREAS, Section 5.1 of the Town Charter establishes the Town Council as the governing and legislative body of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council proactively authorized the installation of electric vehicle charging stations at the Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, due to the increasing demand for this service, the Town experiences significantly demand charges from the utility, which resulted in a suspension of this service; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission is the body designated by state law to establish fees and rates for public utilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED IN COUNCIL that the Town Administrator or his designees are authorized to file a petition to intervene in matters before the Public Utilities Commission addressing electric vehicle charging stations and utility demand charges.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
