To Approve and Fund a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Derry Fire Officers

WHEREAS, Section 5.1 of the Town Charter establishes the Town Council as the governing and legislative body of the Town, thereby empowering the Council to enter into contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Town Administrator, pursuant to Section 8.6 of the Charter, has proposed that the Town enter into a collective bargaining agreement with the union representing the fire officers of the Town of Derry for fiscal years 2022 through 2026: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RSA 273-A, the legislative body must make an appropriation to fund the cost items of a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the cost items of the collective bargaining agreement applicable to Fiscal Year 2022 do not require an additional appropriation, and the Council is aware of and acknowledges the future costs of the agreement, which the Town shall be obligated to fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED IN COUNCIL that the terms, conditions and costs of the "Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Town of Derry and the Derry Fire Officers Unit of the International Association of Firefighters, LOCAL 4392", for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2026, are hereby approved;
