

DERRY MODERATOR'S NOTICE

REGARDING

SIGNS AND PARKING AT THE POLLING PLACE

NOTICE to all citizens, candidates and their supporters regarding the limitations that apply to **political signs and parking** at our polling location during the upcoming October 19th, 2021 Derry State Representative Primary. The only **political signs** that are permitted on West Running Brook property are those that are held by the supporters or candidates within the designated electioneering area. This includes no posting of signs along the street adjacent to the polling place. Each person is limited to two signs or totems up to eight (8) feet in height and 30 inches wide that must be held. No signs are to be affixed to or planted on School property or any Town property. Any unattended signs will be removed by election officials or other authorized personnel. No temporary structures of any kind are to be placed at the polling place on election day. Bumper stickers or placards on legally parked cars are allowed if the sign does not touch the ground.

Attached is a map of the polling place indicating **designated parking for voters only**. Parking in voter's only spaces will be limited to one (1) nonrenewable hour. There is a designated handicapped parking area for voters only limited to one (1) nonrenewable hour. Candidates and their supporters have their own designated area to park in. This is the area where you can park for more than one (1) hour and it is located behind the school. Parking for Candidate Supporters will be limited due to school being in session, please make carpool arrangements.

Broadcasting or amplification of audio by candidates or their supporters will not be allowed on School property. Disorderly conduct of any kind will not be tolerated. Campaign workers are not allowed to approach, yell at or summon voters to talk with them. Polite greetings such as "Hello" or "Thanks for coming out" are allowed. If the voter approaches the campaign worker, then a conversation may ensue. There will be no marked social distancing in the electioneering area, however, please respect those candidates and campaign workers around you that may want to social distance. Please note to your supporters that interfering with parents in the pick up line while they are waiting to pick up their children is not allowed.

These regulations on voting day are supported by RSA 644:2, RSA 659:43 II, RSA 664:17, and various opinions issued by the NH Attorney General. Town Officials are in full support of these requirements which will be enforced by Election Officials and if necessary, by Derry Police.
