To Enter into an Intermunicipal Agreements with the Town of Chester to
Provide Police Prosecutor Services and to Provide a Supplemental
Appropriation thereto

WHEREAS, Section 5.1 of the Town Charter designates the Town Council as the governing and legislative body of the Town, and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter establishes the Town Council as the appropriating authority of the Town and as such it is empowered by Section 9.6 of the Charter to make supplemental appropriations after the annual budget is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chester seeks police prosecution services and the Town of Derry has the capacity to provide those services; and

WHEREAS, entering into a partnership with the Town of Chester would assist its Police Department with its prosecutorial responsibilities while providing additional revenues to assist the Derry Police Department with meeting its workload;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED IN COUNCIL that the Town Administrator is hereby authorized to execute an Intermunicipal Agreement, developed in accordance with RSA 53-A, between the Towns of Derry and Chester to provide Police Prosecutorial Services;

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED IN COUNCIL that the sum of Twenty-One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$21,667) shall be appropriated to hire additional police prosecutorial services from income received from the Town of Chester.


This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
