Ledge

If ledge is encountered on projects under the above reference work the Town will be responsible for costs associated with blasting and/or hoe ramming of the ledge.

Note:

Usage of this item for drainage installation will be based on a typical one-day minimum of work (150-200 linear feet, plus one structure). * Contractors should be aware that the Town will insist that proper compaction techniques be utilized to provide a stable and safe trench. These techniques must conform to N.H.D.O.T. specifications.

These prices are based on installation of pipe in areas with little or no buried utilities on roadways with light traffic. Prices will be renegotiated in areas with multiple utilities and/or high traffic volumes. Furthermore, these prices reflect graveling to grade and do not include pavement restoration.

If conditions or circumstances dictate, the Town reserves the right to revert to the hourly equipment/manpower rates of the contractor performing the work, therefore it is important that contractors who submit bids for this item also submit bids for equipment/manpower rental. Additionally, the Town reserves the right to discharge said contractor if work is not progressing in a satisfactory manner. This decision will be at the Town's discretion.

* The reference to minimum work of 150-200 feet per day refers to installation of new drainage piping; conditions and circumstances may allow or restrict the lineal footage in any particular day.
