### #1 - Response to Vendor Questions

1. If an underground conduit is proposed from basketball area to building at the beach, could the Town of Derry provide the equipment (backhoe) and manpower to dig/recover a trench if vendor supplies the conduit and the installation of the conduit? AKA, will the town open and close the ground for us?

Direct Town support was not envisioned as part of this proposal. For equity in determining the best value for the Town, the vendors should price the project with their own subcontractors to excavate, backfill, compact and restore property to pre-existing conditions.

2. Would it be possible to extend the RFP due date an additional week? With the answers not being published until October 31<sup>st</sup>, and bid due on November 3, that only gives vendors three business days to tweak designs and the answers to questions, may change design significantly.

The Town seeks to fast track this project to deal with security concerns, the responses were posted on Monday, October 30<sup>th</sup> at 900am. Unfortunately, the November 3, 2017 deadline will remain.

### #2 Response to Vendor Questions

- 1) Can you please confirm that the Town will provide 110 volts (constant) AC power for the video equipment?

The Town will insure that a constant power supply can be furnished, which may require the Town to make a modification to the existing feed. This work would be completed either before or concurrent with vendor's work. This question is based on the concept that the feed to the lights are controlled by a timer and are not operative 24/7.

- 2) Does this Bid require prevailing wage labor rates?

This is a locally funded project, no prevailing wage rates are required.
