




Introduction

Derry, with a population of approximately 34,500, is the fourth largest community in New Hampshire. The Town's Fire and Police Departments are housed in facilities that do not adequately support current or future space requirements. Meeting these facility requirements is an important component of being able to continue to provide essential public services safely and efficiently. This Needs Analysis, conducted by Mitchell Associates Architects, PLLC, defines the facility requirements for each department. The analysis addresses options of how the sequence of what gets built affects the overall size of the facilities, and also provides a rough order of magnitude budget for the construction of the facilities.

This needs analysis was conducted through an interactive process of data analysis, observation of operations, and staff interviews. The work product is contained in the Building Design Programs attached at the end of this summary. The work of this study was performed by Robert Mitchell and Michael McKeon.

Robert Mitchell has provided architectural services to the emergency response community for twentyeight years and has been directly involved in the design and/or evaluation of 180 projects addressing more than 320 public safety facilities throughout the Northeast, the Eastern Seaboard, Missouri, Indiana, Texas, and Alaska.

Michael McKeon has practiced architecture for over five decades, having specialized for the past two decades in police and public safety facility programming, planning and design. As a principal at Kaestle Boos Associates, Inc. (KBA), for nearly 30 years, he was responsible for more than 75 police and public safety facility projects.

Description of Conclusions

Police Department

The Derry Police Department currently consists of 59 sworn officers and 10 civilians, including dispatchers, clerical staff, and a mechanic. The programming process has determined that the Department requires a main station of 39,500 square feet to properly support its current and foreseeable operations. In addition to the main station, the following is required:

- A secure 3,500 square foot garage-type auxiliary facility for vehicle storage,
- An 8,500 auxiliary structure to protect operational vehicles from the elements,
- A portion of a new vehicle maintenance facility to be shared with the Fire Department (see below).



Fire Department

The Derry Fire Department provides fire and rescue services to the Town from the Central Station and three substations. Current staffing is:

- Central Fire Station two firefighter paramedics, three firefighter EMTs, one company officer
 and one shift commander. In addition to emergency responders, there is also at least one
 emergency communications specialist on duty in the dispatch center.
- Station 2 (Island Pond) a three-person Advanced Life Support (ALS) Engine Company that cross staffs an ALS Medic Unit (ambulance), Forestry Tanker, Forestry Unit and a Marine Unit.
- Station 3 (English Range Road) cross-staffed with a crew of three, providing fire and emergency medical services at the paramedic level.
- Station 4 (Hampstead Road) cross-staffed with a crew of three, providing fire and emergency medical services at the paramedic level.

The programming process examined the current and foreseeable future needs of:

- A headquarters with staffing of 10 firefighters per shift, up from the current staffing of 7, and a future administrative staff of 15.
- A substation with future staffing of 6 per shift, up from the current staffing of 3.

The fire department needs a new headquarters, a new substation, and a portion of a new vehicle maintenance facility to be shared with the police department.

The programming process has determined that the Department requires a main Fire Station that ranges in size between 36,687 and 37,467 square feet, based on whether it is built after or before a new substation is built. Additionally, the Department needs a substation that ranges in size between 13,105 square feet and 13,978 square feet, based on whether it is built after or before the new headquarters is built.

In addition to the main station, the following is required at its location:

• An auxiliary apparatus storage structure of 3,326 square feet (see below).

Shared Vehicle Maintenance Facility

Both the police and fire departments require a vehicle maintenance facility. The programming process has determined that this facility requires 11,265 square feet. It has a 9,600 square foot footprint, and a 1,665 square foot storage mezzanine.



Options Based on Sequence of Construction

Option 1: Build Combined Public Safety Facility first, Fire Substation later

This option would include a 74,750 square foot combined Fire and Police building as well as the shared Vehicle Maintenance Center, Police Secure Vehicle Storage facility, Police Vehicle Protection structure and Fire Department Auxiliary Apparatus storage to be built first, with the 13,700 square foot Fire Department Substation to be built subsequently.

The comparative cost analysis developed indicates that this option represents the most overall cost-effective approach. The combined facility offers some reduction in building size (2,217 sf or 2.9%) as well a single design-construction process and appreciable operational savings. However, this option will require a site with seven acres of developable surface area and could be more difficult to acquire in an area suitable to the location-sensitive fire service.

Option 2: Fire Substation first, Combined Public Safety Facility later

While this option is based on similar facilities, it shifts the fire training features to the Substation. One disadvantage to this approach is the duplication of the training spaces since the police will continue to require this function in the combined facility. In addition, deferring construction of the larger component of the building program makes it more vulnerable to the still-unknown pandemic-related impact on future costs.

Option 3: Build Separate Fire & Police Facilities first, Fire Substation later

This option contemplates separate 39,500 sf Police, and 37,467 sf Fire headquarter buildings, with the same auxiliary facilities as previously noted.

While not specifically considered for cost comparison, this option could be further explored by building one of the two headquarter buildings first and deferring the other, as well as the fire substation Although this building option is already somewhat less cost-efficient than Option 1, it also requires acquisition of another site (unless separate headquarters are built on a single, *larger* site) and site acquisition costs could add to the cost differential.

Option 4: Build Fire Substation first, separate Fire & Police Facilities later

This option which contemplates the same buildings as option 3 is the least cost-effective of the four options. Again, this option could be further modified by rescheduling construction of one of the two headquarter projects, or even deferring one or more of the auxiliary facilities, so the differential costs could be even greater.

Project Costs Summary

Conceptual hard and soft project costs have been developed for the following scenarios:

- Police headquarters
- Fire headquarters if built before the substation
- Fire headquarters if built after the substation
- Police and fire shared vehicle maintenance garage
- Combined fire and police headquarters built before the fire substation
- Combined fire and police headquarters built after the substation
- Substation built before the fire headquarters
- Substation built after the fire headquarters

The brick-and-mortar costs are based on the following assumptions:

- For a "Low Range" projection for year one:
 - Main building cost per sq ft = \$385
 - Secondary building cost per sq ft = \$250
- For a "High Range" projection for year one:
 - Main building cost per sq ft = \$425
 - Secondary building cost per sq ft = \$276

The spreadsheet assumes a cost escalation of 4%/annum. This affects the values on lines 27 and 29. For each of the optional projects a year has been selected for which it is assumed the project will be built. This is shown on line 24. Based on the year assumed for construction, the cost per sq ft is escalated by compounding the 4% escalation rate. The spreadsheet is meant to be a tool to allow exploration of cost impact of selecting a sequence of construction and seeing the impact of delay. The values shown are budgeting approximations developed for the purpose of this study and cannot be assumed to be correct in the manner that one depends on a construction cost estimate.

Derry Fire Substation Space/Usage Analysis as of 12/13/2021 Assuming Substation is Built First


