RECIPIENT: Town of Derry

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Improvements to the Town of Derry's water distribution system are required to transmit the flow required for the Southern New Hampshire Regional Water Interconnection Project (SNHRWP).

The SNHRWP will use Manchester Water Works (MWW) as a source of supply to address contamination and water supply issues in Windham, Salem, Hampstead, Atkinson and Plaistow. The Project Partners and NHDES entered into a Memorandum of Understanding October 2018, and negotiated a Southern Interconnection Agreement (SIA), which is pending signature by the Parties. The DWGTF and Governor and Executive Council have approved a \$19.6M grant for design and construction of the project, and the MtBE Settlement Fund has committed up to \$7.3M in additional grant funding for design and construction. The target schedule is to begin construction in 2019 and complete Phase 1 by the end of 2020.

The proposed improvements include:

- A new meter station including pumps near the Londonderry-Derry town line on Manchester Road (Route 28);
- Upgrades to the existing Rockingham Road (Route 28) pump station;
- Approximately 9,000 linear feet of 16-inch water main in Rockingham Road (Route 28) from the terminus of the existing Derry water system to a point near the intersection of Route 28 and Northland Road south of the Derry-Windham town line; and
- A pressure reducing valve (PRV), in Derry near the Derry-Windham town line.

A Trust Fund grant is proposed for the full project cost because all of the improvements are necessitated by and solely related to the SNHRWP.
