Said equipment will be used by the Town as a work platform for up to three persons to maintain, remove, replace, install and repair BIOLAC© aeration diffuser assemblies suspended in the Town's wastewater treatment lagoons.

All prices must include all labor and materials with complete delivery of a functioning piece of equipment to the Town of Derry.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

1. <u>RECEIPT AND OPENING BIDS</u>

The Town of Derry, New Hampshire, (herein called the Town) invites bids on the form attached hereto, all blanks of which must be appropriately filled in. Bids will be received by the Town at the Derry Municipal Center, 14 Manning Street, Derry, NH until 2:00pm, prevailing time, Friday, September 22, 2017.

The envelope containing the bid must be sealed, addressed and designated as:

DO NOT OPEN

Bids may be held by the Town for a period no to exceed 30 days from the date of the bid opening for the purposes of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified may not be considered.

2. DESCRIPTION OF PONTOON BOAT WORK PLATFORM

The equipment listed below is to be complete with delivery to the Town of Derry.

PONTOON BOAT WORK PLATFORM

- Work platform shall be of such construction as to support up to three men and three BIOLAC© aeration diffuser assemblies.
- A 1,000 lb. swivel hoist and heavy duty welded slide support capable of lifting six inch diameter polyethylene pipe.
- Min. 8 ft. x 12 ft. marine grade aluminum diamond plate decking with "Z" channel cross members and full body framework for solid frame support with min. 48 inch cutout for easy access to aeration diffuser assembly.
- Min. two (2) 23 in. diameter aluminum pontoons min. 0.125 in. thickness.
- Hull shall include auxiliary floatation using 2 lb. US Coast Guard approved Polyurethane Foam for added structural strength and flotation
- Min. 1.5 in. X 1.5 in. X 28 in. aluminum railings with front and rear access.

- All stainless steel screws and fasteners
- Lifting straps and welded hooks for basin removal and installation.
- Min. 12V Electric Motor capable of min. 50 pounds of thrust with heavy duty battery.
- Min. One (1) year limited warranty

3. PREPARATION OF BID

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed proposal form showing a lump sum for each item and a total for items bid.

Each bid must be prepared in strict accordance with the requirements of the Information for Bidders and the included Specifications

The bid price shall not include Federal or State taxes

The Bidder shall not, either directly or indirectly, enter into any agreement, participate in any collusion, or otherwise take any action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with this bid.

4. SUBCONTRACTS

The bidder is specifically advised that any person, firm, or other party to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract under this Contract must be acceptable to the Town.

5. **<u>BIDDER'S QUALIFICATIONS</u>**

Each Bidder shall submit qualifications to the Town on the form provided herein titled "Statement of Bidder Qualifications". The form must be delivered to the Town prior to or with the sealed bid. The Town reserves the right to reject the bid of any Bidder who has failed to submit the qualifications form.

6. TIME OF COMPLETION

The Bidder must agree to supply the equipment within one hundred, twenty (120) calendar days.

7. ADDENDA AND INTERPRETATIONS

Every request for interpretation should be in writing to the Town, and to be given consideration, must be received at least three (7) business days prior to the date fixed for opening of bids. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the Specifications which, if issued, will be placed on the Town website, not later than two (2) calendar days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Failure of any Bidder to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve such Bidder from any obligation under bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the Contract Documents.

8. LAWS AND REGULATIONS

The Bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable Federal and State laws, municipal ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the project shall apply to the Contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the Contract the same as though herein written out in full.

9. BID OPENING & AWARD

Bids when opened shall be irrevocable for a period of thirty (30) calendar days following bid-opening date. Following a review of the bids, the Town will make a determination with respect to bid award. The Town, expressly reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The successful Bidder shall not use the name of the Town in any advertising without first obtaining written permission for the Town.

10. EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS

The individual, firm, partnership, or corporation to whom or to which the Contract has been awarded shall sign the necessary agreements entering into a Contract with the Town and return them to the Office of the Town within fifteen (15) calendar days after the Contract is mailed or otherwise delivered to the successful bidder.

11. APPROVAL OF CONTRACT

No Contract is binding upon the Town until it has been executed by the Town and delivered to the Contractor.

12. FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT

Failure of a Bidder to comply with any of the requirements of the proposal, failure to execute the Contract with fifteen (15) calendar days after mailing, as specified, shall be just cause for the annulment of the award. In the event of such annulment, an award may then be made to the next best qualified Bidder, or the work re-advertised, or otherwise handled as the Town may elect.

13. WARRANTIES

All manufacturers' warranties shall apply.

14. DELIVERY

The pontoon boat work platform is to be supplied to the Town of Derry, New Hampshire.
