To put together the downtown workshop, all past studies and surveys were gathered and grouped into action items by function area with successes being identified. A recent community survey was distributed among residents and business owners and those results will be presented. All the local stakeholders have been invited and encouraged to participate in this workshop. Exit 4A is a reality and will be happening very soon with only 2 federal permits remaining. The town has been looking at suggestions on how to redevelop Abbott Court. Performing arts downtown has been promoted more frequently. Economic Development Coordinator Bev Donovan has looked into parts of Derry as a Federal Opportunity Zone. These low-income zones receive funding if there are opportunities for redevelopment.
